

Physical Violence with Intent	
Incident 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Class teacher to inform HoP. • HoP to come to the situation and remove the children involved. • Child automatically internally isolated for the rest of that day and the next full day. • HoP /SC to record on tracker and ring the parents. • HoP /SC to meet with the parents at the end of the isolation period to discuss expectations for returning to class. • HoP to sign Fighting Letter 1. • Parents to sign Fighting Letter 1
Incident 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AD to come to the situation and remove the children involved. • Child automatically internally isolated for the rest of that day and externally excluded for 1 day. • AD to record on tracker and ring the parents. • AD to meet with the parents the morning the child returns to school to discuss expectations for returning to class. • Parents to sign Fighting Letter 2.

These sanctions will be carried out over the course of the academic year. Children will be given a ‘fresh start’ each September.

If an act of physical violence occurs in the classroom or playground, teachers must send a child/teacher with a red card to alert a Senior Leader.

If the HoP or AD cannot be contacted, the child will remain with the Deputy Head or School Counsellor until the HoP/AD becomes available.

Internally isolated children:

- Will remain with a Senior Leader for the duration of their isolation.
- Will not be allowed out to break or lunch but will be internally isolated for the duration of the day.
- Will not take part in any, intervention or sports clubs after school for the duration of their isolation.
- The SL will provide work initially for an afternoon isolation but then the class teacher **MUST** provide class related work for the remainder of their isolation.
- The SL will arrange for the Primary School counsellor to meet with all internally excluded children before returning to class.
