MATHS

Before we move on to bigger numbers, we will also learn how to subtract across 10 and from a 10. We will use different concrete resources to aid understanding of different maths concepts.

Science

Our focus is on materials and their properties, recognising, classifying and identifying them. We will research where different materials come from, as well as test and record their properties. We will finish off by learning all about 'Reduce, Reuse and Recycle' and enroll in an investigation, learning how to make a fair test, predicting what might happen and giving a conclusion.

P.S.H.E.E.

Our focus will be on understanding conflict and how to recognize when others are being unkind, how to deal with situations and who to confide in. We will be celebrating Remembrance Day, Anti Conflict Week and Odd Socks Day.

ART
