

ENGLISH

In English we will start by analysing a science-fiction text, and then planning and rewriting our own version of this text. Following on from this we will be working on identifying the techniques used to create imagery and mood in a poem, using 'The Frozen Man' as a reference. Finally, we will be using the 'Man on the Moon' advertisement to work on features of a newspaper report, involving direct and reported speech.

MATHS

In Maths, we will continue with the theme of multiplying and dividing integers by 10, 100 & 1000, carrying out similar calculations with multiples of these e.g. $__ \times 50$, $__ \div 200$. Following this we will move onto fractions; finding equivalent fraction, changing improper fractions into mixed numbers and vice-versa as well as working on the addition and subtraction of fractions (including calculations with mixed numbers).

P.S.H.E.E.

This term finds us celebrating various important dates such as Remembrance Day, odd-socks day and anti-conflict week. We will also be celebrating our differences, inspiring ourselves by people with disabilities who have achieved great things.

MUSIC

This term we are learning to perform music in preparation for Christmas.

TOPIC - HISTORY
