

ENGLISH

In English we will start by analysing features of non-chronological reports, based on the text 'Walking with Unicorns', with the purpose of pupils creating their own NCR. Afterwards we will begin analysing a fiction text (The Red Eye), through hot-seating, creating our own story maps and role-plays before planning and writing our own version of text, making use of various literary techniques. To finish with, we will study examples of Spike Milligan's poetry.

MATHS

This term, we will begin with multiplication: first multiplying a number (up to 4 digits long) by a 1-digit number, before moving on to multiplying by 2-digit numbers. These operations will be carried out using a variety of methods. We will then move onto division, dividing (up to) a 4-digit number by one digit. Finally, we will look at, fractions: multiplying fractions by integers; finding fractions of amounts and comparing them to decimals and percentages.

P.S.H.E.E.

Islam and Sikhism are our targeted focus areas this term in PSHEE. The children will be taught a few of the key traditions and practices of these faiths; however, more importantly, there will be a key focus on the importance of respecting the beliefs and opinions of others.

MUSIC

This term we are learning to compose and perform music.

P.E.

Hockey will be our main team sport, with children practicing key skills and learning some rules. They will also participate in gymnastics.

TOPIC – HISTORY - VIKINGS

We will be looking at how, and why, they invaded other countries, as well as learning about their daily lives, religious beliefs, art... Much of the aforementioned information will be self-taught through investigations using books, factsheets and the internet.

COMPUTING

One of the key focus' for the children this term is the use of numbers (macOS word processing program). Student will be taught: to identify and read cell references; to input and edit data, to format data cells and to use formulae as a more efficient way of carrying out calculations.

SCIENCE

We are studying Earth and the Planets this term in science. Children will be researching the eight main planets as well as learning about the sun and moon. We will also be looking at how, and why, ideas about space have changed over time and are still changing. Furthermore, we will be looking at how these celestial bodies interact with each other.

ART

We will begin by further developing the children's current drawing techniques, through looking at pop art. They will be introduced to the work of artists such as Andy Warhol and Roy Liechtenstein, analysing the colours and styles used by each.
