



British School of Tenerife Uniform Policy

Early Years

All Early Years pupils must wear the official BST P.E. tracksuit with white or navy blue socks and trainers. The BST tracksuit is available from the school office at La Luz. The official school t-shirt is available with long or short sleeves for children in this department.

(Long sleeved t-shirts may not be worn under the official school t-shirt.)

Hairstyles for Boys & Girls Years 1 to 11

Hair no shorter than a "number 2" cut and no razor-cut lines. Longer styles must be tied back with a navy elastic.. No unnatural hair colours allowed and no extreme hairstyles. No headscarves except for religious or cultural reasons

BOYS Years 1 to 11

Long or short DARK grey school trousers (available from school office at La Luz)

BST official blue polo t-shirt (available from the school office at La Luz)

BST official navy blue sweater (available from the school office at La Luz)

BST official navy blue jacket (available from the school office at La Luz)

Navy blue socks

Plain navy or black school shoes (not trainers)

GIRLS Years 1 to 11

BST blue tartan skirt, (available from the school office at La Luz)

Long or short grey trousers (available from school office at La Luz)

BST official blue polo t-shirt (available from the school office at La Luz)

BST official navy blue sweater (available from the school office at La Luz)

BST official navy blue jacket (available from the school office at La Luz)

Navy blue socks

Navy blue or black school shoes (not trainers)

Navy blue hair band or elastic

The above uniform is worn daily except on the day your son/daughter has P.E. lessons.

(Long sleeved t-shirts may not be worn under the official school t-shirt.)

Anoraks:

During cold weather pupils/students will be allowed to wear a plain dark navy blue anorak over the **official** school jacket. Please note that the anorak must NOT be branded or have any form of logo.

Caps or hats can be worn outdoors but must be removed on entering the school building (can be worn at break times if it is too sunny).

“Hoodies” can be worn under the school jacket, but the hood must be down once the student enters school.

Sunglasses may be worn outside; however the school is not responsible for damage or loss.

Students who wear inappropriate school uniform will not be able to wear them in school.

P.E. Uniform: (available from the school office at La Luz)

The **official** school tracksuit comprises of a navy blue tracksuit, navy blue shorts and a light blue t-shirt.

Students must wear white or navy blue sports socks **only**.

Senior pupils must bring 2 official P.E. t-shirts to school on the day they have sports. They are required to change into a clean school t-shirt after the lesson.

The correct footwear is **white, blue or black sports trainers** (fluorescent trainers are not allowed). Trainers should not have black soles.

No skate boarding shoes or canvas shoes to be worn. Students who do not wear the correct P.E uniform will not be allowed to participate in P.E lessons.

Example Trainers for P.E.



Shorts **MUST** be worn during sports lessons (**tights may not be worn under P.E. shorts**).

Jewellery should be removed for P.E lessons.

Jewellery: Allowed in Secondary School only

2 rings

A watch

A bracelet

A chain necklace (no other type of necklace may be worn)

Ear-rings must be stud ear-rings and no more than 2 pairs may be worn.

No jewellery in Primary school except stud earrings and a watch.



The uniform policy must be strictly adhered to. Pupils will be asked to remove jewellery if it does not conform to the above. If an item of jewellery is confiscated it will be returned at the end of the school day.

If a student repeatedly flaunts the rules, then they will have to stay for detention after school in secondary; or will miss a brake in primary.

All items of the school uniform MUST be labelled clearly!
