Early Years

All Early Years students must wear the official BST P.E. tracksuit with white or navy-blue, black or grey socks and trainers.

The official school t-shirt is available with long or short sleeves for children in this department. **Long sleeved t-shirts may not be worn under the official school t-shirt.**

Hairstyles for Boys and Girls: Early Years to Year 6

Hair no shorter than a "number 2" cut and no razor-cut lines. Longer styles must be tied back with a navy elastic. No unnatural hair colours allowed and no extreme hairstyles. No headscarves except for religious or cultural reasons

BOYS Years 1 to 6

Long or short DARK grey school trousers.

BST official blue polo t-shirt.

BST official navy-blue sweater.

BST official navy-blue jacket.

Navy-blue, black or grey socks.

Plain navy-blue or black school shoes (not material/canvas) with dark soles.

Navy-blue hair band or navy-blue elastic.

Long sleeved t-shirts may not be worn under the official school t-shirt.

- The above uniform is worn daily except on the day your child has P.E. lessons.
- **All items of the school uniform MUST be labelled clearly**

GIRLS Years 1 to 6

BST blue tartan skirt.

Long or short grey trousers.

BST official blue polo t-shirt.

BST official navy-blue sweater.

BST official navy-blue jacket.

Navy-blue, black or grey socks.

Plain navy-blue or black school shoes (not material/canvas) with dark soles.

Navy-blue hair band or navy-blue elastic.

Long sleeved t-shirts may not be worn under the official school t-shirt.

- The above uniform is worn daily except on the day your child has P.E. lessons.
- **All items of the school uniform MUST be labelled clearly**

Anoraks:

During cold weather students/students will be allowed to wear a plain dark navy-blue anorak over the **official** school jacket. Please note that the anorak must NOT be branded or have any form of logo. Caps or hats can be worn outdoors but must be removed on entering the school building. "Hoodies" can be worn under the school jacket, but the hood must be down once the student enters school. Sunglasses may be worn outside. However, the school is not responsible for damage or loss. Students who wear inappropriate school uniform will have these items, where possible, confiscated until the end of the school day. Students who wear inappropriate school uniform will not be able to wear them in school.

P.E. Uniform:

The **official** school tracksuit comprises of a navy-blue tracksuit, navy-blue shorts and a light blue t-shirt.

Students must wear white or navy-blue sports socks **only**.

The correct footwear is **white, blue or black sports trainers** (fluorescent trainers are not allowed). Trainers should not have black soles. Skate boarding shoes or canvas shoes are **not** to be worn. Students who do not wear the correct P.E uniform will not be allowed to participate in P.E lessons.

- The above uniform is to be worn only on the days your child has P.E. lessons.
- **All items of the school uniform MUST be labelled clearly**
- Any items of jewellery **MUST** be removed for P.E lessons.

Example of acceptable trainers to be worn for P.E.



Shorts **MUST** be worn during sports lessons (**tights may not be worn under P.E. shorts**).

Jewellery:

With the exception of a wrist watch (no SMART WATCHES) and one pair of stud earrings, no other jewellery is allowed.

Nail polish is prohibited.

Students will be asked to remove jewelry if it does not conform to the above. If an item of jewellery is confiscated, it will be returned at the end of the school day. If a student repeatedly flaunts this rule, then jewelry will be returned at the end of the school day, then the matter will be pursued through our behaviour policy.

It is at the discretion of the school management to decide if what a student is wearing is suitable for school or not. The School Management reserves the right to review and amend these regulations at any moment
