

BRITISH SCHOOL OF TENERIFE-EARLY YEARS CLEANING AND WASHING CHILDREN PROCEDURE

- Two staff to be present at all times when a child is being cleaned.
- Prepare the bath with warm water and collect all items together that are required.
 - Baby bath
 - Soap
 - Children's clean clothes
 - Gloves
 - Plastic apron
 - Towel
 - Plastic bag
- Ensure that appropriate PPE is worn during this procedure.
- Check temperature of the water.
- Take off all items of clothing and place them in the bath.
- Wash the child with soap and water.
- When the child is clean lift him/her out of the bath and dry with a towel.
- Dress the child and take them back to the classroom.
- Rinse the child's dirty clothes in the bath with clean water and place them in a plastic bag clearly labelled with their name.
- Place the plastic bag on the child's peg or bag ensure this is collected and handed to parents when the child goes home.
- Clean the bath using anti-bacterial spray and disposable paper.
- Place the towel in the washing machine.
- Wash hands thoroughly.
