ENGLISH

This term our English work will focus on adventure stories. Our class text this term is 'Jumanji' by Chris Van Allsburg and the children will use this text to help them to write a story based on the Jumanji game. Our non-fiction unit this term will focus on chronological reports. We will read a range of biographies and autobiographies and the children will begin to write and illustrate an autobiography of their own! MATHS

The children will learn to tell the time on the digital and analogue clock and solve worded problems related to time and measurement. We will also be Identifying the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. The children will develop their reasoning and problem-solving skills this term with a variety of one-step, two-step and multi-step worded problems

MUSIC

This term we will be singing a variety of songs, exploring the use of percussion instruments and learning some simple dance steps.

ART

Children will explore a range of Aztec artefacts and images to learn more about Aztec art. They will use a range of collage materials to make Aztec mosaics, Aztec masks, headdresses, jewellery and armour. The children will also develop their observational drawing skills by sketching Aztec artefacts.

TOPIC - HISTORY

The focus of our topic lessons this term is the Aztecs. The children will discover where the Aztecs originated and how they lived. They will explore a range of artefacts to learn about Aztec culture, religion and history. We will celebrate our learning by dressing up as Aztecs and learning an Aztec dance!

COMPUTING

Our computing this term will be linked to our science work on plants. The children will create graphs and pictograms with information gathered from their own Excel document. They will create their own simple documents by sorting and classifying plants into groups of their own choice.

SCIENCE

Our science focus, this term is *Living Things and Their Habitats*. *Children* will recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment. They will understand that different food chains occur in different habitats and recognise that environments can change, which can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

P.E.

The children will be exploring dance this term. They will interpret different stimuli with imagination and flair, structure movements and patterns with artistic understanding and describe, interpret and evaluate dance, using appropriate language and terminology.
